
our next production : AURELIA by Robert Thomas

The first production for 2023 is *Aurelia*, a tantalising thriller by Robert Thomas, directed by Trish Richings.

Wealthy art collector Lady Chalmont lives in a cottage in the Cotswolds, cared for by her housekeeper/ companion, Vera. Years before the good Lady's nephew, John, left under a cloud of suspicion to go abroad, leaving behind not just his Aunt but also

Isabel, the young woman who had become infatuated with him and was a regular visitor to the cottage. Then out of the blue a letter arrives saying John is coming back to England with his new bride.

When the time comes his beautiful, but mysterious wife, Aurelia, arrives but without her husband and soon insinuates her way into the household. Yet all is not



what it seems. As the web of lies and deceit grows increasingly elaborate, this dark, engaging thriller takes ever more deadly twists and turns.

Featuring performances from Lesley Drew as Aurelia, Margaret Kennedy as Lady Chalmont, Tanya Baxter as Isabel, Ann Mabey as Vera, Peter Barnes as Mercer and Lee Coleman-Powney as a mysterious visitor, this intriquing play will keep you entertained and guessing to the end.

The show opens on Friday 3 March 2023 and runs through to the following Saturday 11 March with a matinée only on Saturday 4 March. Evening performances commence at 7.45pm and the matinée will start at 2.30pm.

So book your seats now for a night at the splendid home of Lady Chalmont where you will be amused, captivated and beguiled by her assortment of guests and visitors.

Dorothy was, for many, many years, a stalwart of Seaford Little Theatre, acting, directing, set designing and building, stage managing, and doing a vast assortment of unsung jobs behind the scenes to keep the theatre going.

As a director she was clear, precise and inclusive in getting what she wanted, and as an actor she was an award winning performer who was a joy to share the stage with, equally at home in dramatic or comedic roles, with an innate sense of comic timing, and all the sensitive nuances to convey a serious character. It was a huge loss to the Little Theatre when her health forced her to retire, and her joy and enthusiasm for everything theatrical will be greatly missed by all her friends and colleagues here. Our deepest sympathy goes out to her family at this sad time.


