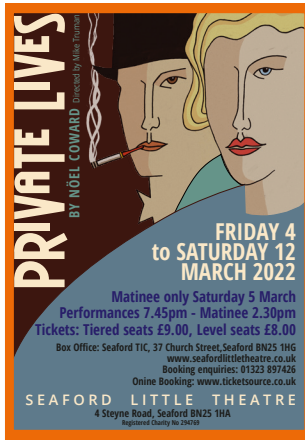
our next production : *PRIVATE LIVES* by Noël Coward

Our opening production for 2022 is Noël Coward's sophisticated and celebrated comedy of manners, *Private Lives*, directed by Mike Truman.

Two honeymooning couples, Elyot and Sibyl Chase and Victor and Amanda Prynne, are occupying adjoining hotel rooms in France. Unfortunately Elyot and Amanda were previously

married to each other, but had parted ways due to their highly volatile relationship. Their unexpected reunion rekindles their earlier passion and they desert their new spouses and run off to Paris in an attempt to recapture that intimate connection.

This cynical and witty commentary on love and marriage stars Jon Terry as Elyot, Sandy Truman as Amanda, David Hallett



as Victor, Lesley Drew as Sibyl and Margaret Kennedy as the French maid Louise, and is full of Coward's trademark humour and barbed dialogue.

The show opens on Friday 4 March 2022 and runs through to the following Saturday 12 March with a matinée only on Saturday 5 March. Evening performances commence at 7.45pm and the matinée will start at 2.30pm.

As ever, the safety of our audience is paramount and

This is one of Noël Coward's most brilliantly realised plays and features an excellent stellar cast, so book your seats now and get your New Year off to a splendid start.

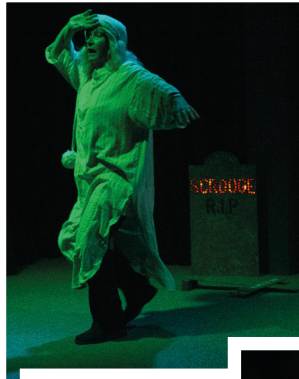

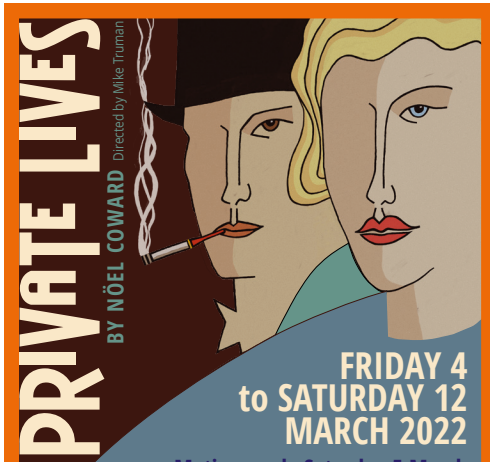
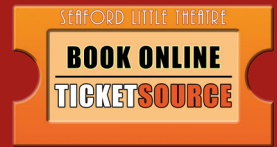
